I believe that our neighborhood is at a disadvantage compared other neighborhoods in the area because of the quality of what was put in here. People tend to take what they see and expand upon it, instead of taking the design elements back to 'basic principles' and rethinking their approach. Most (not all) of these elevations are dated and "kitschy". They would not be built here again. 




